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Dear Customer,

This is your true-up statement for your PG&E Net Energy Metering account with an interconnected solar (photovoltaic) or wind generator.

This lists your total cumulative energy charges/credits(-) for this true-up period including any current month energy charges/credits(-). If you have any net annual charges as listed below, you will also see these on your current monthly blue bills. Any excess energy credits for the true-up period will not be applied to your next true-up period. The net metering program was designed by the legislature for systems sized to customer load on an annual basis; currently approved tariffs and legislation provide that no credit be carried forward to the next true-up period.

Any payments you may have made are reflected on your monthly blue bills. Excess payments you have made over this true-up period will be applied toward your future bills.

TOTAL TRUE-UP BILLED AMOUNT: \$12.88*

*This amount includes True-up Energy charges and current month's billed amount and is reflected on your regular monthly blue bills. It includes the following components:
Transmission \$11.67, Distribution \$11.24, Public Purpose Programs \$0.17, DWR Bond Charge \$5.24, On-Going CTC \$6.91, Energy Cost Recovery Amount \$3.42, Generation \$-26.62, Energy Commission Tax \$0.25 and Utility User Tax \$0.60.

If the electric total charge on the blue bill for this month is very large, it is because you have been paying your energy charges on an annual basis. You have an option of paying your energy charges monthly in the coming year. Under the Net Energy Meter program you may pay all or part of your energy charges on a monthly basis rather than waiting until true-up bill. To be eligible for a Net Surplus Compensation, your net trueup usage must be negative. If you do not meet these requirements, your credit eligibility will be reviewed at the end of your next annual trueup period.

True-up billed amount

This represents the final amount owed after all energy charges, credits and previously-billed monthly minimum charges have been reconciled at the 12-month True-up. If you generated more energy than you used over the True-up period, this amount also includes your Net Surplus Compensation.

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Net Surplus Compensation

If you generated more energy than you consumed over the entire 12-month True-up period, you will be eligible to receive payment for the excess energy sent to the grid. Compensation will be a market price of approximately 4 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) and will be factored into your True-up billed amount.

Generation includes charges for the portion of your energy usage provided by the Department of Water Resources (DWR) and collected by PG&E as DWR's agent. In 2011, DWR projects to return \$280 million to bundled customers. The average amount returned for each kWh of energy provided by DWR is projected to be 10.873 cents. DWR also collects the Power Charge Indifference Adjustment component of the Cost Responsibility Surcharge from CGA, Direct Access and Transitional Bundled Service customers.
